Summary:

The project aims to fight the gender-based violence phenomenon by acting in areas such as prevention, victim protection, and promotion of integrated policies across the territories of Catanzaro, Crotone, and Cerreto Sannita. The proposed project is to be integrated within initiatives already in place and developed both by the project leader and by the partner—the social cooperative *Noemi*. In an effort to assist more cases, 'Camper delle Donne' (A Women's Camper) will start operating and in this way provide support services to women who have experienced gender-based violence. An additional initiative is to implement a skills transfer between territories, where the service providers of the anti-violence centres in Catanzaro and Crotone will train the service providers of the newly established anti-violence centre in Cerreto Sannita. In order to interrupt the economic dependence of women who have experienced gender-based violence, a career guidance services will be offered and about 8 job placements in local companies will be available for a period of 12 months. Furthermore, a particular attention will be paid to the gender-violence phenomenon in the world of female drug addiction, by providing specialized training for service providers and by defining an action plan. The beneficiaries of the above-mentioned initiatives will be approximately 80 women survivors of violence coming from local anti-violence centres and/or who have been reached by the partners during information campaigns.

Summary:

The project intends to establish an inter-institutional, anti-violence network in the province of Avellino designed to empower women at risk by providing orientation, training, social and work (re)integration and by educating the new generations about healthy relationships. It will include adopting and agreeing on a working protocol for the service providers in the anti-violence network, a service guidelines for women victims of violence, as well as training programmes with periodic supervision for the service providers. The project further plans to implement a career guidance and job orientation through traineeships and job placements in local companies and setting up an expense fund which will contribute towards women's financial independence. Finally, training courses will be offered to schoolchildren, teachers, and parents on gender stereotypes and equal opportunities. Beneficiaries of the initiatives will be about 100 women victims or potential victims, nearly 40 child victims and witnesses of violence, and around 2,000 students and parents.

Summary:

The project aims to promote living and working independence of women in the Sanità District of Naples, by supporting their process of leaving violent situations. More specifically, in a space provided by the Association *A Ruota Libera*, an assistance desk will be set up and offer career guidance, psychological and legal support. For women who are leaving the shelters and in support of their semi-independence, 9 traineeships and 6 accommodation grants will be available. Further, this project plans to strengthen the network between the institutional services, the associations and the psychological assistance desks *Dafne Center*, located at the Emergency Room of the Cardarelli Hospital. It also includes specific activities in support of minors who have witnessed violence, parenting courses and workshops, and awareness-raising activities offered in 10 local schools. The project is expected to reach approximately 600 women victims of violence and up to 40 minors, victims of secondary violence.

Summary:

The main objective of this project is to take full charge of issues surrounding violence against women in the 5 provinces of Calabria (Catanzaro, Cosenza, Crotone, Vibo Valentia, and Reggio Calabria). A social and work (re)integration of women survivors of violence will be provided by offering support (self-help and peer-to-peer assistance, self-defence courses and online counselling), the activation of 44 job placements, and the opening of 5 anti-violence assistance desks. Additionally, educational courses on healthy relationships will be carried out in 25 schools and involve a total of 150 students, 150 parents and 500 teachers. Overall, the project aims to reach about 1,000 victims or potential victims of violence who have been identified at the reception facilities, by the municipal social services and by the service providers at the assistance desks.

Summary:

The project intends to strengthen, in several municipalities of the province of Naples, services to combat violence against women and treatment services for abusive men; to integrate the project beneficiaries in the social and professional circle; and to start educational courses on healthy relationships. A professional training course will be held for about 30 women survivors of violence, 10 of whom will be involved in setting up a marketing company to promote social farming products. This project also plans a data collection and activity support of the anti-violence centres, which will collectively contribute to standardize the operational procedures. A counselling assistance desk for abusive men will be opened and courses aimed at increasing emotional awareness in children and young people in different school grades will also be available. Overall, the project will reach a total of 190 women survivors of violence, coming from the local anti-violence centres.

Summary:

The project aims to create a well-connected, anti-violence network, which will support and care for women and children survivors of violence in the province of Palermo. In particular, 3 counselling centres and one shelter will be opened in the municipalities of Altavilla Milicia, Villabate, and Palermo. Various activities will also be put in motion to promote independence of women survivors of violence including: establishment of a social cooperative and an e-commerce platform to sell agricultural products. Finally, awareness-raising activities will be provided for local residence and educational courses will be available in local schools on the topics of *affection and assertiveness*. The project is expected to reach about 50 women survivors of violence, 10 of whom will participate in the establishment of the cooperative.

Summary:

The project aims to put a spotlight on the violence against women phenomenon in certain isolated and poorly connected places in the province of Salerno, intervening both on the development of services and on strengthening the independence and self-sufficiency of women survivors of violence. Specifically, the project will offer training for up to 50 service providers who work in this field and activate 8 mobile anti-violence centres, managed by the partners (Aretusa in Atena Lucana and IRIS - assistance desk Pierangela in Sapri). The mobile centres will cover 35 municipalities of the 2 territorial areas (S9 and S10) with set opening hours and will in addition offer health screenings for about 30 women. Moreover, the project plans specific activities to support approximately 120 women survivors of violence towards independence by offering traineeships, career and job-search guidance, and housing assistance (co-housing, voucher). Finally, educational courses on healthy relationships will be offered for nearly 100 high school students. The project, in all, will support about 80 women survivors of violence, 20 survivors of trafficking and 20 survivors of sexual exploitation, who have been reached by the mobile and the established anti-violence centres.

Summary:

The project, which is being developed in the province of Foggia, aims at strengthening the prevention services and exposing of violence against women cases. In particular, a training course will be provided for the anti-violence service providers of the province to change them into 'guards against violence.' Their tasks will be reaching victims or potential victims of violence, conducting risk assessment for repeated offences, creating and offering strategies to leave abusive situations, and supporting self-recovery. At the same time, there will be initiatives for social and work-related inclusion for about 55 survivors of violence through the launch of career guidance services, 'arts and crafts' workshops, entrepreneurship training courses, professional matching with companies and 24 job placements. A total of 20,000 Italian and foreign women at risk of intimate partner or non-partner violence are expected to be reached and approximately 250 of which will be directly involved in the available activities.

Summary:

The project intends to promote various activities to combat gender-violence in the three territories of Puglia: Lecce, Taranto, and Bari. In particular, it provides social and work inclusion initiatives for about 14 women as well as co-housing experiences connected to the anti-violence centres and managed by the network of the three municipalities (Parabita/Lecce, Martina Franca/Taranto and Noci/Bari). With regard to exposing and awareness-raising of gender-violence issue, the project will offer educational workshops in schools, development sessions for service providers and volunteers, and public events. Up to 60 women survivors of violence and 35 minors who have witnessed violence will be cared for and supported.
